Evaluation of Instrumental Music

Instruction in Music offers a variety of benefits to students and specifically aids three notable areas of child development: their social, physical and mental well-being. Players of musical instruments must learn how to keep in time, play their part correctly, and work together as a unit. 9th Odyssey International






