It is reported that Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin spent nearly three hours walking on the lunar surface. They collected samples, conducted experiments and took photographs.

"The sights were simply magnificent, beyond any visual experience that I had ever been exposed to," Armstrong once said. Armstrong was a modest and simple person. He never allowed himself to be caught up in the celebrity and glamour. He said once, "I am, and ever will be, an engineer. And I feel proud of my own profession."

Armstrong was born on August 5, 1930, on a farm near Wapakoneta in the Western Ohio, USA. He took his first airplane ride at age of 6.
