सन् १९५३ मे २९ मा नेपालका तेन्जिङ नोर्गे शेर्पा न्युजिल्यान्डका सर एडमन्ड हिलारीले पहिलो पटक सगरमाथामा पाइला टेकेका थिए । सगरमाथाको चुचुरोमा मानव पाइला टेकिएको आज ७१ वर्ष पुगेको छ । हालसम्म हजारभन्दा बढीले सगरमाथाको

Sachin elected as school captain

News Reporters- Press Team Hetauda, June 5, 2024 Solidarity International Academy has announced its new school captain for the academic year 2081. The election was held on 23rd of Jestha in the school premises in the chairmanship of Election Commissioner. Miss Reena Acharya and our Social teacher Pradip Sir, as the election officer. Sachin Yadav and Sanskar Gnyawali were candidates for the election with symbol of Bat and Dhaka Topi respectively. The voting process commenced at 10:30 am, with the involvement of Students from 6-10 as voters. The total number of votes was 518. Two polling stations and one ballot box were managed in the election.



The voting concluded at 12:30 p.m. The election process was notably organized and smooth, although initially, there was speculation that teachers also might participate in voting. However, it was later clarified that the School's Captain's role primarily focused students' representation, which justified the exclusion of teachers from the voting process. Vote Counting started at 1:40 pm in the presence of vice principal Coordinators, election officer and the Election commissioner.

During the Counting the competition was intense especially as the vote tally progressed. After counting the 100 votes, Mr. Sachin had 62 votes while Mr. Sanskar had 35, with 3 invalid votes. The trend continued with Mr. Sachin maintaining the lead throughout the counting stages. The final tally showed Mr. Sachin with 289 votes, resulting in Mr.Sachin winning by a significant margin of 75 votes.

The election result was announced on the same day at 2:30 pm. Congratulations were extended for both candidates for their efforts and sportsmanship from the Election Commissioner.
