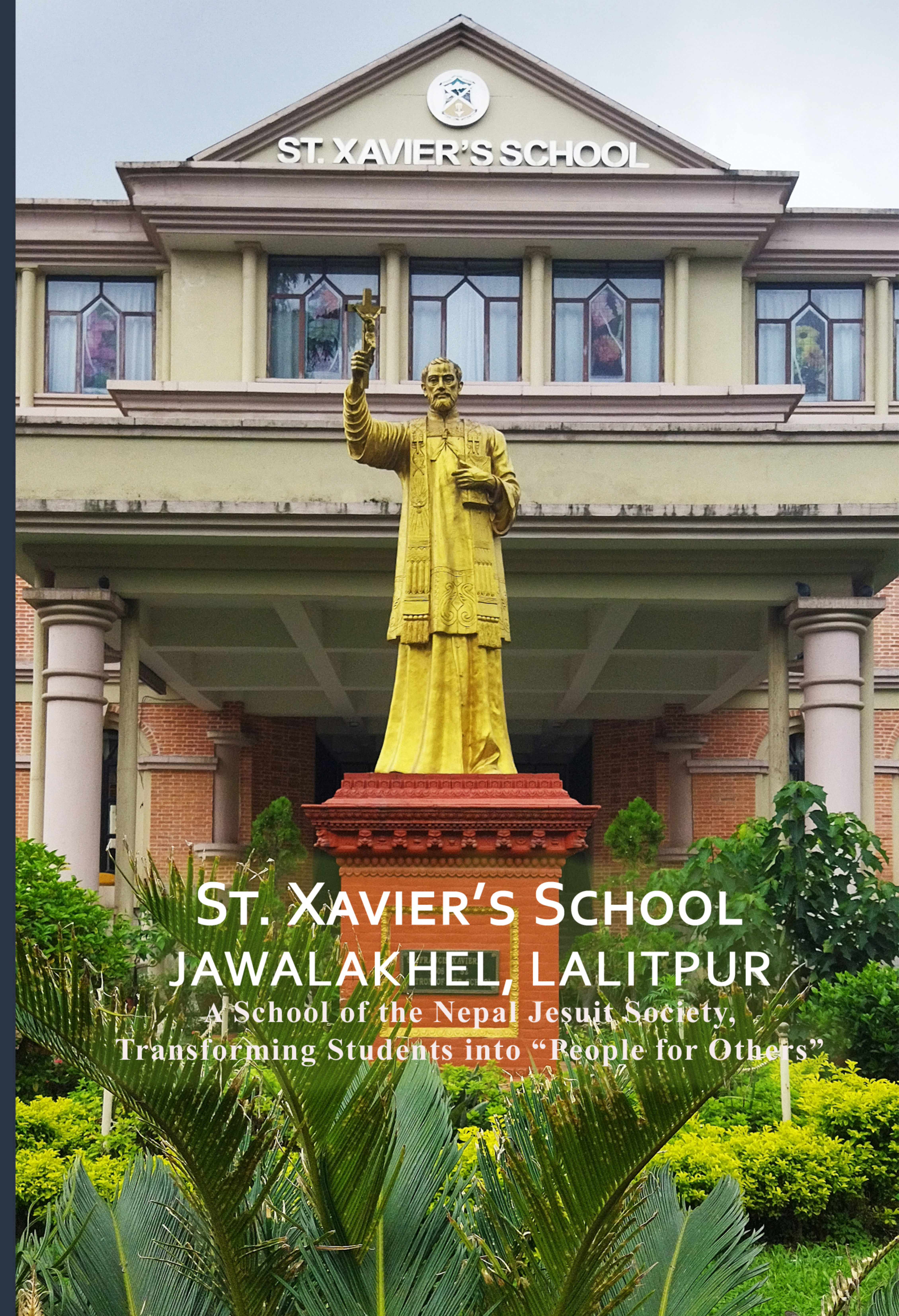




Objectives of Jesuit Education

HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL

Fr. Marshal D. Moran, S.J. of the Patna Province of the Society of Jesus visited Nepal in October 1949. General Mrigendra Shamsheer Rana, the Director of Public Education informed Fr. Moran that the Government wanted the Jesuits to start a school in Nepal (Nov. 1950). Fr. Moran together with Fr. Francis Murphy and Fr. Ed Saxton arrived in Kathmandu on June 6, 1951 and proceeded to Godavari, where the government offered them land, a few old buildings and horse stables. The pioneers underwent a lot of struggle to convert these rooms into classrooms.



St. Xavier's School (Est-1951) was the first academic institution established by the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) in Nepal. Currently, it consists of student cohorts in twelve levels from Grade 1 to Grade 12 and operates an elementary school, a middle school, and a high school under a single administration. One of the oldest private schools in the country, St. Xavier's has historically been considered an inclusive institution for the students from all walks of life.

The alumni of this institution have traditionally occupied high ranking positions within the government, bureaucracy, military or in other distinguished professions nationwide.
