#### Overview

The Workshop on Peer-Reviewed Article Writing, held from 21st to 27th Poush 2081, was a comprehensive seven-day event designed to enhance the research and academic writing skills of both teaching and non-teaching staff at United College. The workshop provided participants with a deep dive into the process of writing articles for peerreviewed journals, focusing on key areas such as article structure, writing clear and impactful abstracts, and understanding the nuances of the peer-review process. It also covered essential aspects of academic publishing, including ethical considerations, selecting appropriate journals, and how to effectively respond to reviewer comments. Experienced facilitators, who were accomplished researchers and published authors, guided the participants through hands-on activities, group discussions, and peer review sessions, allowing them to apply the concepts directly to their own research topics. These interactions provided constructive feedback that helped participants refine their writing and improve the overall quality of their work. By the end of the workshop, attendees gained practical knowledge and strategies for writing, revising, and submitting articles to reputable journals. The collaborative learning environment, along with the expertise of the facilitators, fostered a sense of confidence and empowerment in participants, equipping them to contribute to the academic community and strengthening the research culture at United College. The workshop proved to be a valuable opportunity for professional development and academic growth.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the **Workshop on Peer-Reviewed Article Writing** was to provide both teaching and non-teaching staff of United College with the necessary skills to learn, write, refine, and publish research articles in the United Journal of Interdisciplinary Studies (UJIS), a peer-reviewed journal of the college, as well as in other reputable research journals. The workshop aimed to guide participants through the essential stages of academic writing.

#### **Methods**

- Resource Persons: The workshop featured three expert resource persons, including Dr. Lal Rapcha, Campus Chief; Dr. Binod Lingden, Research Coordinator; and Dr. Dhruba Lal Pandey, Associate Professor at Tribhuvan University. These facilitators brought in-depth knowledge and expertise in research and publishing, offering participants valuable insights and practical advice on writing and submitting peer-reviewed articles.
- Participants: The workshop was attended by thirty-three both teaching and non-teaching staff of United College. The teaching staff included faculty members from programs such as BBM, BBS, BCA, and MBS, while the non-teaching staff represented a variety of departments within the college.

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- Materials: A variety of materials were used to ensure the smooth running of the workshop. These included laptops, projectors, markers, proposal writing manuals, notebooks for note-taking, pens, banners, HDMI cables, chargers, adapters, and wireless clickers for presentation control. Microphones and speakers were used to ensure clear communication with larger groups or virtual participants. Additionally, cameras recorded and documented the sessions for future reference. Participants had access to the internet and research databases, enabling them to conduct live research sessions. Collaborative platforms such as Google Docs and shared drives facilitated document sharing and group activities, enhancing collaboration and learning.
- Format: The workshop followed a blended format, combining various teaching and learning methods to ensure maximum engagement. It included lectures, interactive sessions, individual work, group discussions, Q&A sessions, and hands-on activities. This format allowed participants to actively engage with the material, collaborate with peers, and receive direct feedback from facilitators, ensuring a comprehensive learning experience.
- Venue: The workshop was conducted over seven days. The first five days took place in the computer lab at United College, providing an environment equipped for inhouse sessions and individual work. On the sixth and seventh days, the workshop shifted to Himalayan Drishya Resort in Dhulikhel, offering a serene and focused atmosphere conducive to more reflective and intensive work.
- Date and time: The workshop took place from 21st to 27th Poush 2081. The first five days were held from 7 AM to 9 AM at United College, focusing on key topics in article writing. The evening sessions from 4 PM to 8 PM on the sixth day, and from 7 AM to 9 AM on the final day at Himalayan Drishya Resort, provided a more relaxed and collaborative environment for refining articles and preparing for publication.

#### **Evaluation**

The Workshop on Peer-Reviewed Article Writing, conducted from 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> Poush 2081, received highly favorable feedback based on participant evaluations through surveys and informal discussions. The evaluation focused on the participants' acquisition of knowledge, development of skills, and overall satisfaction with the workshop. Participants reported a significant improvement in their understanding of the entire process of writing and submitting peer-reviewed articles, particularly in areas such as article structure, writing a compelling introduction, crafting a strong literature review, presenting results, and drawing insightful conclusions. The hands-on activities, including group work, peer reviews, and interactive writing exercises, were particularly appreciated, as they allowed participants to actively apply their learning and refine their drafts with feedback from both facilitators and peers. Facilitators were praised for their expertise in breaking down complex academic writing concepts into practical steps, making the writing process more manageable. The workshop's interactive format, which encouraged engagement and discussion, was considered one of its most effective features. Additionally, the venue at Himalayan Drishya Resort for the final two days provided a serene and focused environment, conducive to both collaboration and individual work. Participants expressed increased confidence in their ability to write, revise, and submit high-quality articles to peer-reviewed journals. Many attendees also highlighted the importance of understanding the publication process and how to navigate reviewer comments. Overall, the workshop was regarded as a great success in enhancing participants' article-writing abilities, with many expressing their intention to use the skills

gained to publish in United Journal of Interdisciplinary Studies (UJIS) and other academic journals.

#### **Outcomes**

The Workshop on Peer-Reviewed Article Writing, held from 21st to 27th Poush 2081, resulted in several positive outcomes for the participants, significantly enhancing their academic writing skills and preparing them for successful article publication.

One of the primary outcomes was the participants' increased understanding of the entire process of writing a peer-reviewed article. By the end of the workshop, participants were able to structure their articles effectively, from crafting a compelling introduction to writing clear and concise conclusions. They gained proficiency in key areas such as literature review development, research methodology articulation, data analysis presentation, and proper citation and referencing. These skills are essential for producing high-quality articles suitable for publication in reputable journals, including United Journal of Interdisciplinary Studies (UJIS) and other academic outlets. Participants also became more adept at revising and refining their work through peer reviews and feedback from facilitators. They learned how to incorporate constructive criticism and respond to reviewer comments, making their articles more likely to succeed in the peer-review process. This hands-on approach helped demystify the publication process, empowering participants to confidently prepare their work for submission. Moreover, the workshop fostered a greater sense of collaboration among participants, as they shared insights, experiences, and challenges related to academic writing. This collaborative environment helped participants improve their articles while also expanding their professional networks. Many attendees expressed their intention to use the knowledge gained from the workshop to submit their work to UJIS and other journals, contributing to the growth of academic research within their respective fields.

In the long term, the workshop is expected to have a lasting impact on the participants' research output and publication success, helping to elevate the academic standing of United College. It also contributed to building a more robust research culture within the institution, where both teaching and non-teaching staff are better equipped to write, refine, and publish high-quality peer-reviewed articles.

#### **Conclusion**

The Workshop on Peer-Reviewed Article Writing, held from 21st to 27th Poush 2081, was a highly successful and enriching experience for all participants. Through expert guidance and interactive learning, attendees gained essential skills in structuring, writing, revising, and submitting peer-reviewed articles.
