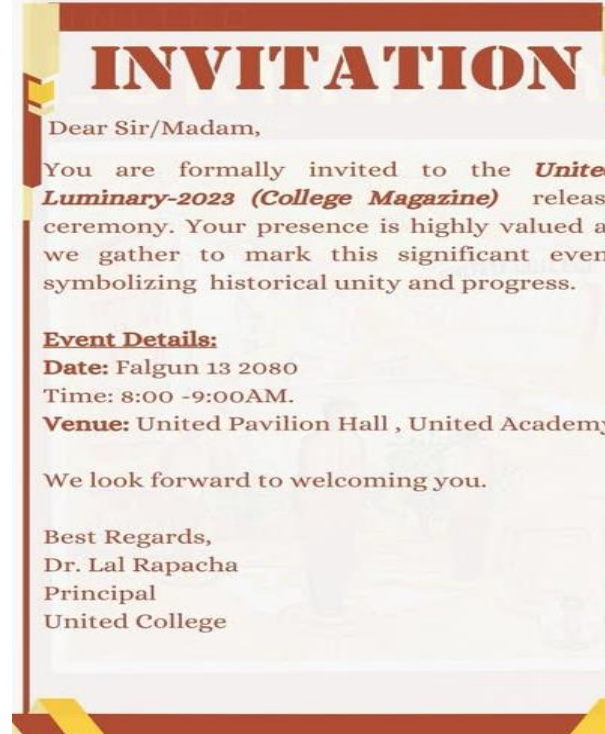


United Luminary Unveiling Ceremony

Special Guest: Mr. Dharanidhar Khatiwada, Former Secretary, Government of Nepal

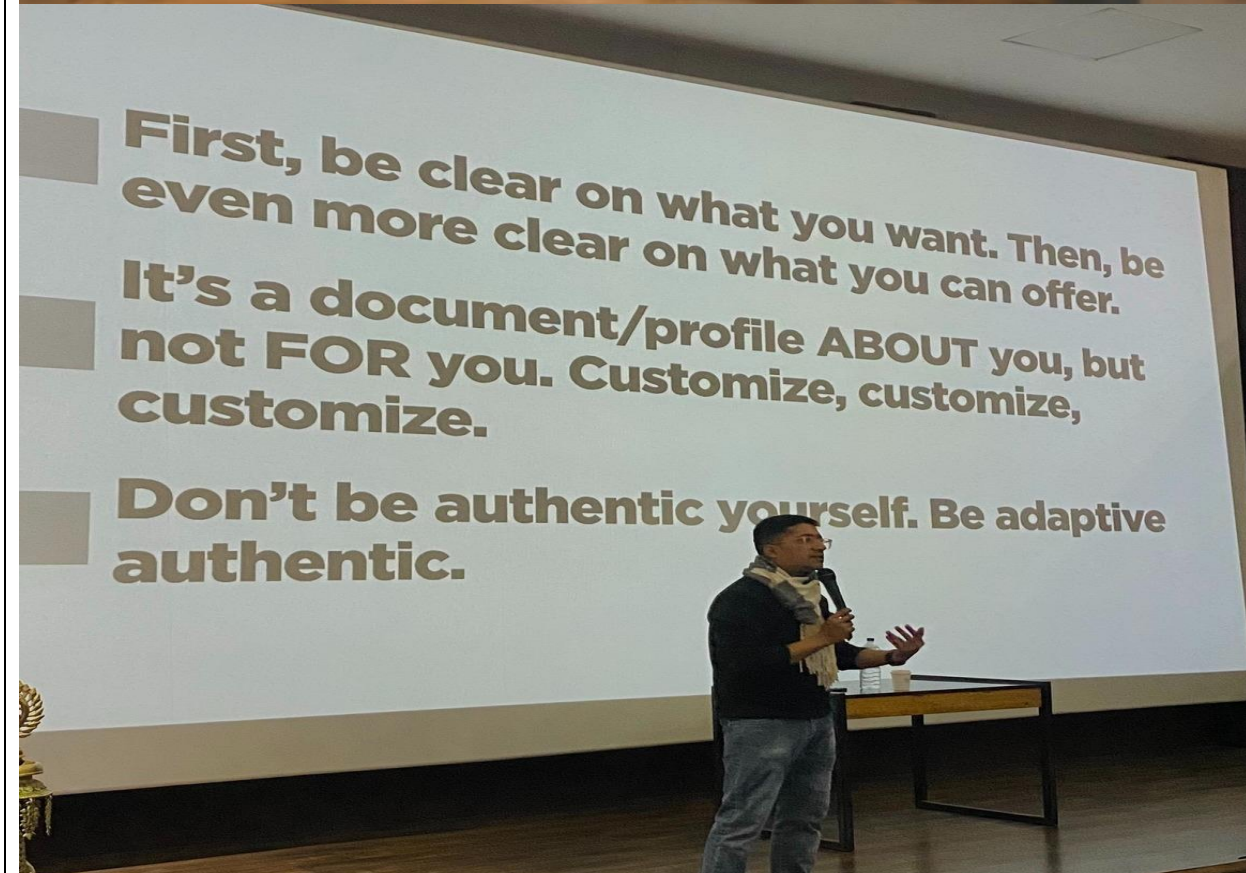
In collaboration with Apex Educational Academy, the session offered students insights and strategies for excelling in Lok Sewa examinations.
