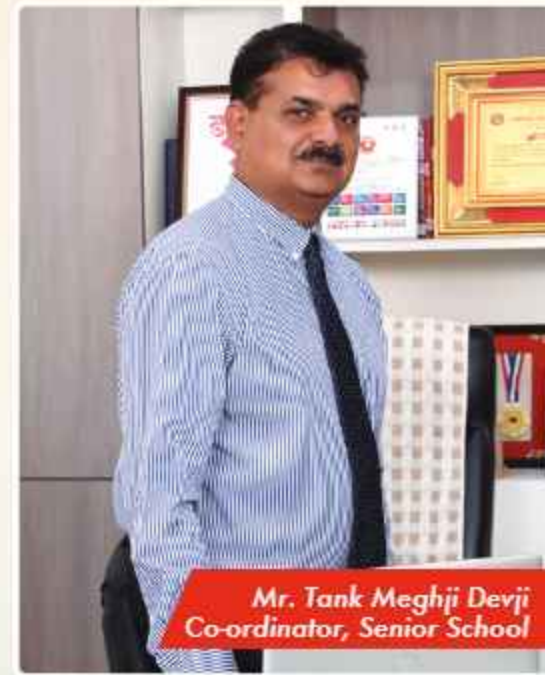

Surroundings

Kathmandu Valley is the centre for cultural and political activities of the country. The valley known for rich cultural heritage has various world heritage sites that help to attract thousands of tourists from all over the world. The valley includes Kathmandu, Lalitpur and Bhaktapur districts covering an area of 220 square miles. The valley may have been inhabited as early as 300 BC. The valley hosts World Heritage Sites composed of seven different Monumental Zones.

The centers of the three historic cities- Kathmandu, Lalitpur and Bhaktapur are Hanuman Dhoka, Patan and Bhaktapur respectively. The two most important Buddhist monasteries; Swayambhunath and Boudhanath and two famous Hindu shrines, Pashupatinath and Changu Narayan are the antique monumental glory of the valley. 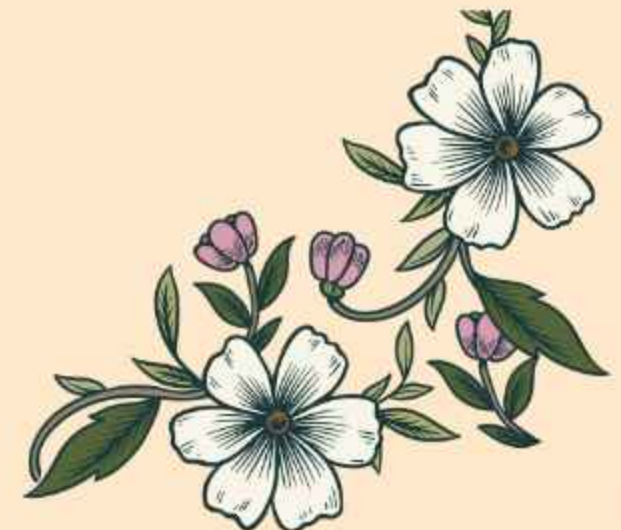
In Nepal, DAV School was established in 1992 by one of the prominent social workers, late Shankar Lal Kedia becoming the founder of DAV Movement in Nepal.

School of Modern Age

DAVSKVBS runs in two blocks:

i) Shankar Sadan ii) Indu Sadan

Indu Sadan includes 3 buildings, one with the heritage model and rest two are a marvel of modern architecture. Lower Secondary and Senior secondary students are instructed in different blocks here.

Curricular Activities

Boards and Affiliation

The school offers the curriculum of CBSE and SEE boards. At the +2 level, the students may opt for one of the streams between Science and Commerce. Similarly, the students get a broad spectrum of subjects which they can choose to suit their interest at the school level also.

Pre-Primary:

The curriculum focuses on psychomotor and cognitive development of children. Creative expressions and general awareness of things, people and places are encouraged through interactive activities like art and craft, music, language, role-play, sports, etc. A firm foundation for formal learning is built by enhancing listening, speaking, reading and writing skills of the children.

Primary:

At primary level, the curriculum prescribed by DAV College Trust of DAV Management Society, New Delhi and the curriculum of Government of Nepal have been adapted in such a way that the learners receive the best of the three systems. The curriculum's objective is to develop students' social, emotional, physical and cognitive abilities to make them lifelong learners.

Lower Secondary

At this level, the students are given option to choose between the curriculum of the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, and National Examination Board, Nepal.

Secondary Level

At the secondary level, focus is on increasing learning productivity, achieving social and national integration, accelerating the process of modernization and inculcating social, moral and spiritual values. Courses of both NEB and CBSE consist of certain core subjects common to all and certain optional subjects.

Higher Secondary

The curriculum prescribed by CBSE, New Delhi is followed at +2 level. At this level the courses are diversified in such a manner as to enable students to specialize in a specific stream with considerable freedom and elasticity. The +2 courses provide an opportunity and a means to get acquainted with appropriate vocationalisation. Assignments are tailored to encourage independent study to achieve a level of knowledge beyond subject's requirement and take additional projects.

Research and Publication Center



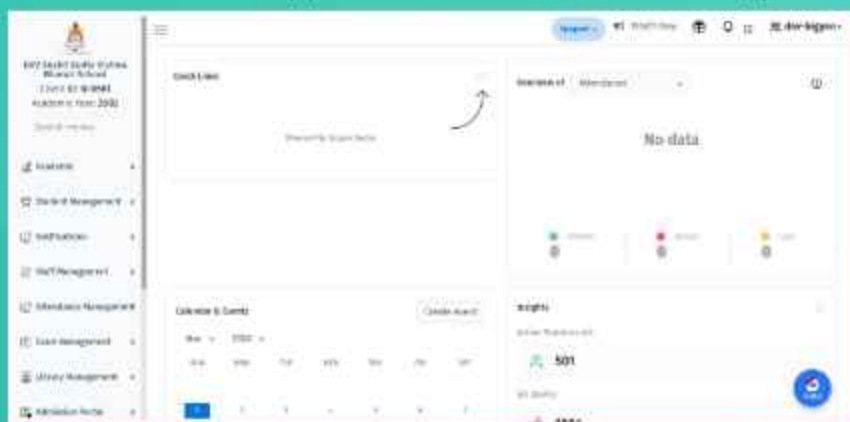

The school caters the need of growing dependence on technology with full-fledged IT department. The computer based education in the school enables every child to meet the requirement of techno-education of the 21st century.

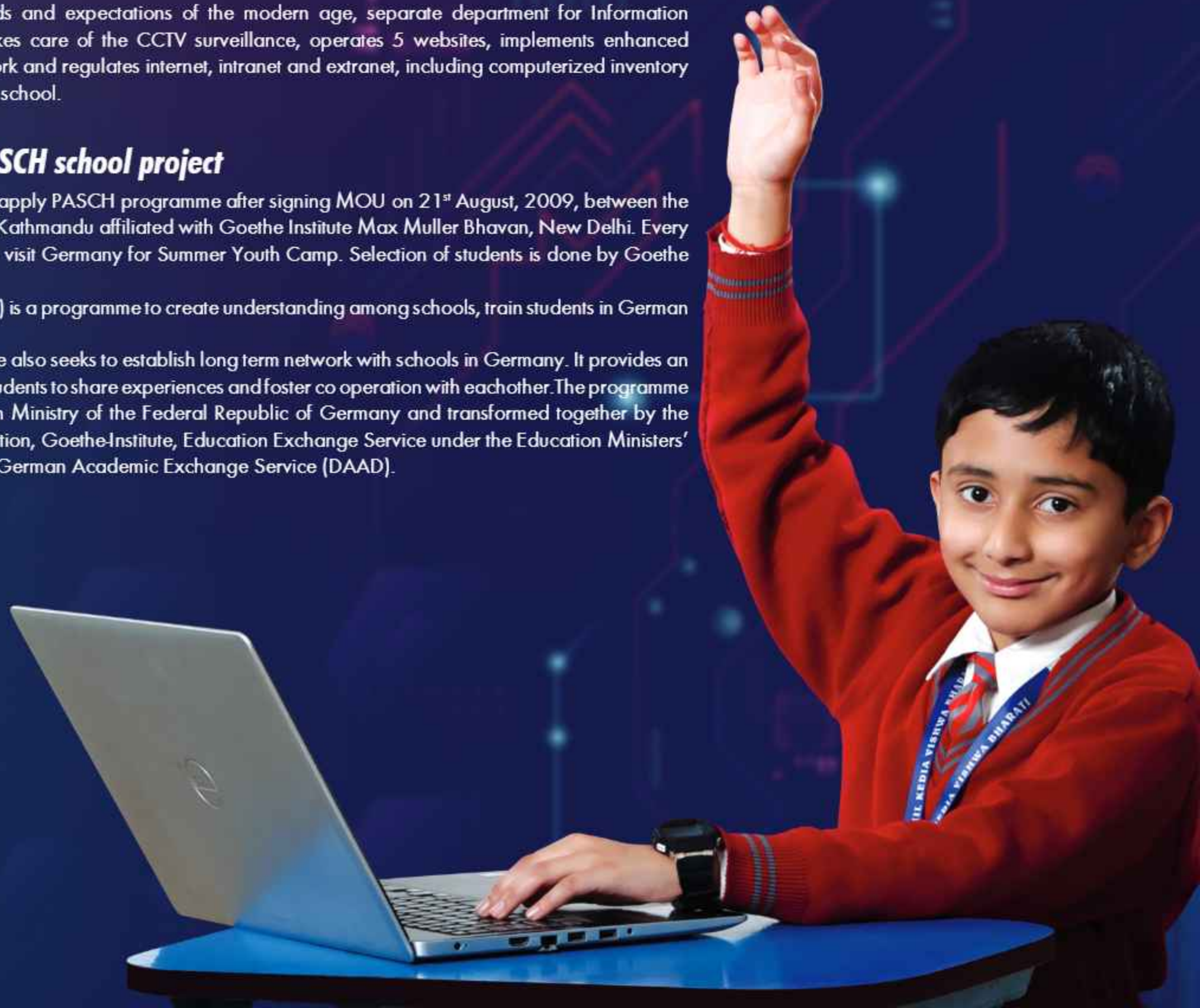
To maximize the needs and expectations of the modern age, separate department for Information Technology in the school takes care of the CCTV surveillance, operates 5 websites, implements enhanced attendance system with network and regulates internet, intranet and extranet, including computerized inventory system on the premises of the school.

DAVSKVBS under PASCH school project

DAVSKVBS agreed to apply PASCH programme after signing MOU on 21st August, 2009, between the school and Goethe Zentrum, Kathmandu affiliated with Goethe Institute Max Muller Bhavan, New Delhi. Every year, 2 students of DAVSKVB visit Germany for Summer Youth Camp. Selection of students is done by Goethe Institute, Kathmandu.

Partner school (PASCH) is a programme to create understanding among schools, train students in German Language.

The PASCH Programme also seeks to establish long term network with schools in Germany. It provides an opportunity to teachers and students to share experiences and foster co operation with each other. The programme is coordinated by the Foreign Ministry of the Federal Republic of Germany and transformed together by the centre for International Education, Goethe-Institute, Education Exchange Service under the Education Ministers' Cultural Conference and the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD).





Co-Curricular Activities

We have six Houses namely Annapurna,, Dhaulagiri, Gaurishankar, Kanchanjanga, Lhotse and Machhapuchhre. The students represent their Houses in various activities. The activities organized in the school are:

Physical Activities

Games, sports, athletics, gymnastics, yoga and martial arts by specialized coaches train students in all the disciplines.

Aesthetic and Cultural Activities

Music (vocal and instrumental), dance, drama, anapana meditation and camps.

Sports Activities:

A balance has been struck between academic activities and co-curricular activities for the development of integral human personality which has great educational value.

House Activities

The House system has a special function at DAVSKVBS. The students are divided into six Houses-Annapurna, Dhaulagiri, Gaurishankar, Kanchanjanga, Lhotse and Machhapuchchhre. Each House is an autonomous unit under the care of a House in-charge assisted by the different subject experts. It is a structured community within which the students develop the feelings of loyalty, responsibility of living in a family and leadership. The houses compete in a wide variety of fields like dance, music, debate, quiz, drama, sports etc. In fact, these activities test the students and encourage them to explore their hidden talent.





Recreational Activities

Dance and Music

Strong emphasis is laid on music and dance. Indian classical & Nepal folk dance, western music and dance, instrumental music and singing are offered to students to develop interest in dance and music. All the children take part in at least one activity at the annual cultural event.

Tours

Educational tours to historical or tourist places are conducted at the National and International level. These trips inculcate knowledge of languages, cultures, customs, traditions, flora and fauna.

Excursions

DAVSKVBS generally plans two excursions in a year - one for seniors and the other for juniors. The places of excursion are especially the places of historical importance.

Movie Shows

'Fabulous Funday' is a popular programme among the students that provides them an opportunity to watch informative English movies along with their classmates.

Educational Field Trips

Under this programme, students go for one day visit local areas to complete their project works, followed by report submission.

International Student Exchange Programme

DAVSKVBS firmly believes that national and international student exchange programmes equip the students with the knowledge of different cultures and help to explore the world in a better way. Furthermore, it enhances teaching-learning activities. The students, at regular intervals, visit India, Germany and the USA. The school management is working to expand it to Sri Lanka and Switzerland in coming years.

Multilingual Approach

DAV focuses on multilingual approach. At our school, Students get more options to learn languages. Besides English, which is the medium of instruction for many subjects, DAV offers languages like Chinese, French, German, Hindi, Pali and Sanskrit. DAV is a pioneer school in Nepal offering many languages to the students as a part of their syllabus.

Grades VI, VII, VIII and IX students can opt for one of the three languages (Chinese, French and German) as their additional language subjects. Similarly, grade IX students of CBSE board have options to choose from Sanskrit, Hindi and Nepali languages. On the other hand, for SEE board students, language subject remains limited to Nepali. The students learn Pali language as a part of Pariyatti Education which is mandatory for the students of grades VI, VII and VIII.



Anapana Meditation

In order to help the students to develop equanimity of mind in the ever-changing scenario, Anapana meditation is practiced daily in the school during assembly hour. Meditation helps the students to introspect, sharpen intellect and develop memory power. Our well-trained staff conducts the Anapana meditation. Restless students and students with poor concentration power are specially advised to attend Anapana Meditation on regular basis.



Health Care

The school infirmary provides first aid at the school. Regular medical check-ups and health camps are organized for the students by the Nurse-Incharge. Students with minor ailments are treated at the school infirmary. In case of emergency, children are taken to the nearest hospitals and parents are informed immediately.

Different wellness programmes are also conducted for students, teachers and staff.



DAVSKVBS-HISSA (Alumni Association)

The Alumni of the DAV Sushil Kedia Vishwa Bharati School is aware of the need to foster close relationship among Alumni, to help promote the interest and needs of their alma mater, and to encourage responsible alumni involvement and participation in school and community affairs.

Disciplinary Norms

Discipline in DAV refers to internal self-control. Discipline is not imposed but its values are so inculcated in the students that discipline becomes inherent. A positive approach to discipline is taught. At DAV, students should take note of the following:

1. Regular attendance and punctuality shall be observed.
2. Participation in all academic as well as co-curricular activities is a must.
3. Entry into the school premises in school uniform only (except for special occasion).
4. Compulsory attendance in Vipassana meditation if prescribed by school authority.
5. Misconduct in the form of disobedience, breaking school rules and regulation will be considered as serious offence.
6. Non-vegetarian food on the school premises is strictly prohibited.
7. Students are not allowed to bring self-driven personal vehicles in the school, except bicycles.



ISO 9001:2015

DAV Sushil Kedia Vishwa Bharati School is the first ISO certified school in Nepal as it was awarded ISO Certificate "ISO 9001:2000" for the first time in the year 2002 and the institute was upgraded with ISO 9001:2008 on 15th July 2009 and with ISO 9001:2015 on 22nd July, 2025. This was awarded to the organization for maintaining quality service as per the criteria of the international standards.

Creating Careers:

DAVSKVBS, established in 1993 is in the field of education for 34 years now. With four premier institutions in Nepal, it aims at creating knowledge centers in the fields of Management, Science, International Business and Information Technology.

Multimedia Classrooms

From the session 2016-17, DAV introduced high-tech multimedia classrooms for the students of grades XI and XII. These multimedia classes have been specially designed keeping in mind the needs of 21st century learners. The classrooms of Grade VII to XII are equipped with smartboard from Academic Session 2024-25. For students, these classes are helpful to make presentations more effective. Moreover, the multimedia classes are being used for video conferencing and live classes to prepare for various competitive exams.

Lunch Facility

At DAV we provide 100% vegetarian food to our students. The hygiene of the kitchen and food is thorough! checked and ensured that it meets the need of the growing minds and bodies of our students. Moreover, providing fresh meal and pure drinking water is the utmost priority of DAV canteen. From the session 2016-17, DAV canteen started providing lunch facility to all the students for whom bringing lunch from home is not feasible.





Orientation Programmes

Besides providing time to time orientation to the students, we provide orientation to the parents because they play an important role in helping students set their academic goals. Orientation programmes provide an excellent opportunity for both the parents and students to interact with school principal, wing coordinators and subject teachers on various issues related with academics.
