Admission Procedure

To apply for the BBA/BBM program at D.A.V., students need to complete application forms with comprehensive details. This includes providing personal information and past academic records. The selection of students shall be based on a two-step process: written test and interview.

Eligibility

A candidate seeking admission to BBA/BBM program must fulfill the following requirements:

- Minimum D+ Grade in each subject of grades 11 and 12 with a CGPA 1.8 or above.
Or
A minimum score of second division in 10+2, PCL or equivalent in any discipline.
Or
- Students who have passed grade 11 and are waiting for grade 12 results can also apply. However, they have to submit passed certificate of grade 12 at the time of admission.

A candidate seeking admission to BBS program must fulfill the following requirements:

- Applicants must have a minimum of D+ Grade in aggregate in the examination of +2 or equivalents in any discipline from a recognized board or university.

Internal Assessment/Evaluation

Internal assessment includes first and second assessments and semester end (send-up) test, which constitute 40% marks. The marking scheme for the internal evaluation has been divided into the following sub-divisions:

- I and II Assessments
- Group Discussion/Problem Solving
- Semester End (Send-up) Tests
- Case Study/Presentation
- Attendance
- Field or Project Work
- Discipline
- Home/Class Assignment
- Term Paper Writing



The Board Examination

The final exam of the semester will be worth a total of 60% of the grade. The examination is administered by the Office of the Dean, Tribhuvan University. Case studies, comprehension questions, analytical questions, and questions requiring problem-solving knowledge are all included in the Board Exams.



An Overview of BBA Program

The Tribhuvan University-affiliated BBA program lasts four-years (eight semesters) and entails 120 credit hours. The program gives students access to modern management theories, methods, and tools while also giving them the chance to develop expertise in any of the functional areas of management.

An Overview of BBM Program

BBM, affiliated to Tribhuvan University, is a four-year (eight semesters) program that consists of 120 credit hours. The BBM program offers an intellectually challenging curriculum which provides students with knowledge and wisdom for careers in business and entrepreneurship.

An Overview of the BBS Program

The BBS program, affiliated to Tribhuvan University, strives to equip students with practical business knowledge, enabling them to become proficient professionals in the contemporary global business landscape. This program focuses on fostering both academic excellence and practical competence to prepare students for success in the field of business management.

The BBS curriculum at D.A.V. is structured after its well-regarded BBA counterpart. The college adopts the BBA approach to support its students by incorporating daily presentations, assignments, extra-credit lectures, as well as training sessions.

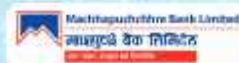

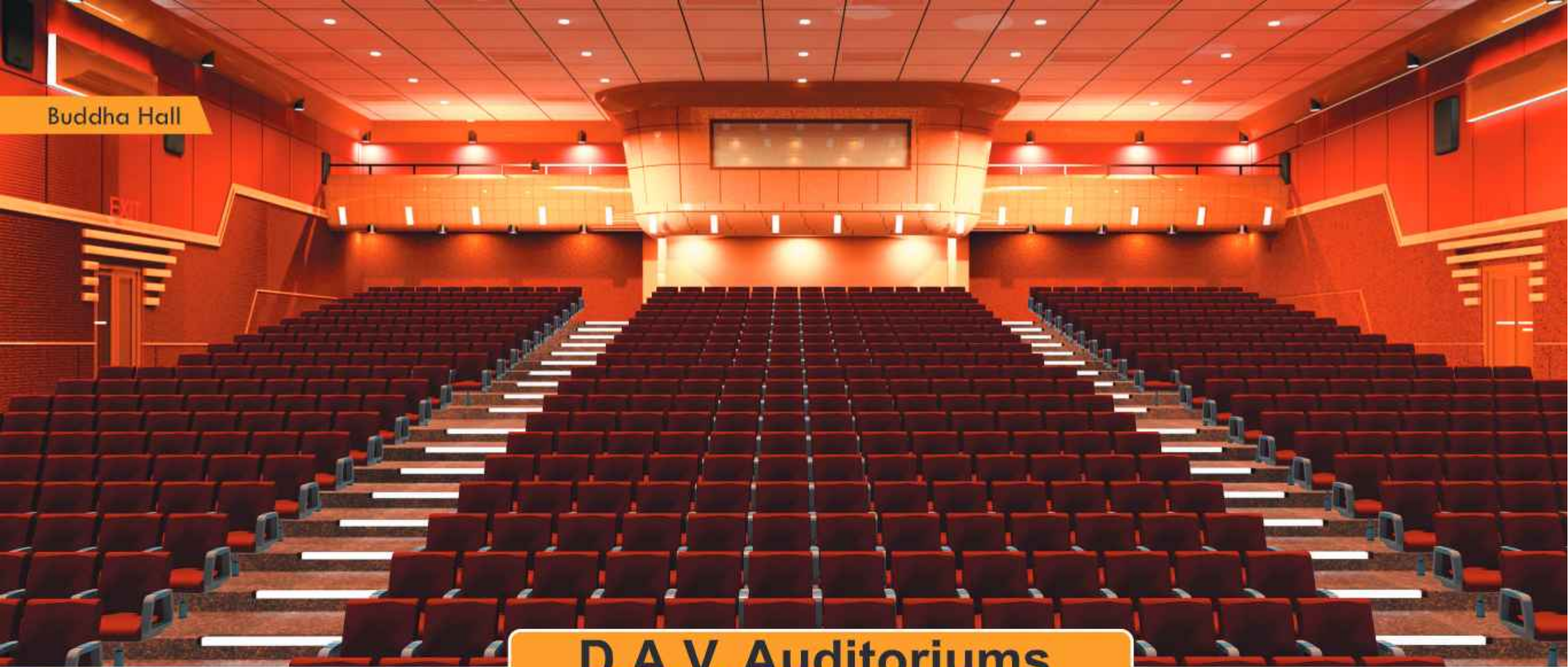

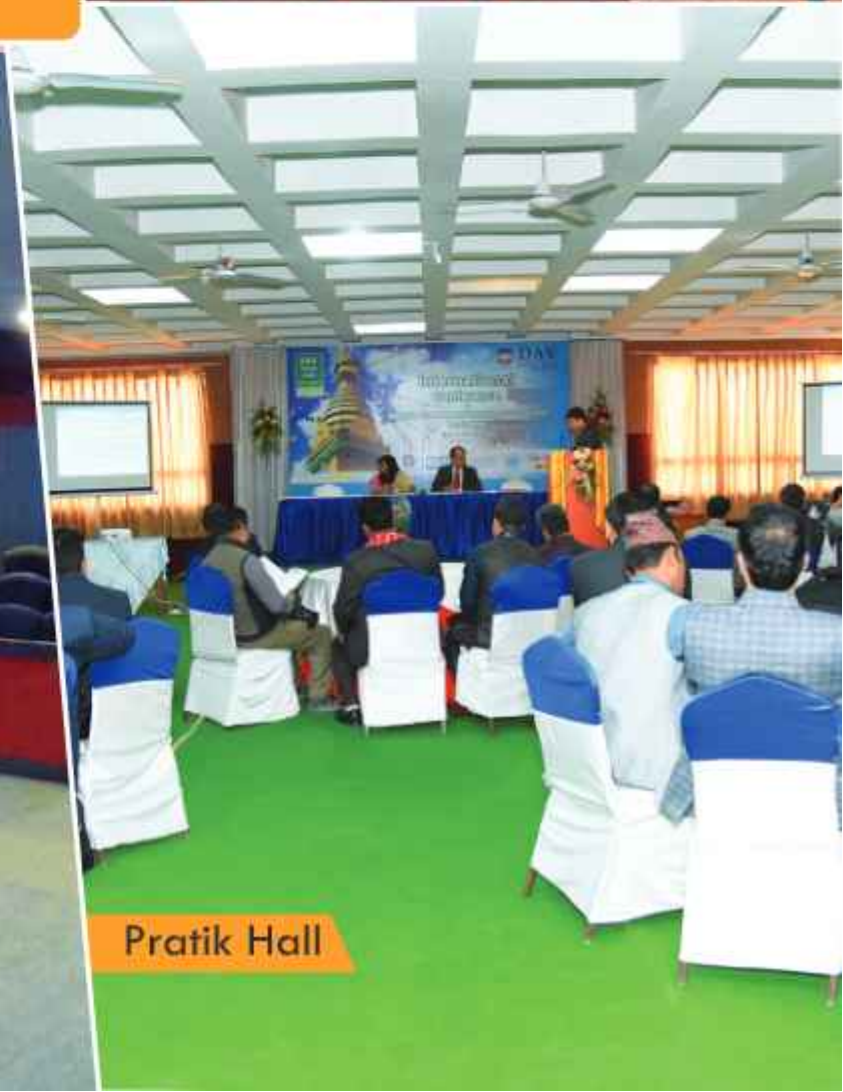
