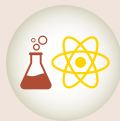

LEARNING APPROACHES



PROJECT-BASED LEARNING

Project-Based Learning (PBL) shifts the teaching-learning approach from a traditional teacher- and textbook-centered model to a dynamic, student-centered paradigm. This approach fosters a strong sense of curiosity, motivating students to analyze information, explore real-world issues, and develop independent, well-informed ideas—often thinking outside the box. By applying logical and rational reasoning, students enhance their creativity and problem-solving skills. PBL also facilitates collaboration among teachers, parents, and the community, creating a supportive learning environment that enriches students' educational journeys. Additionally, it offers opportunities for students and teachers to co-design projects, ensuring authentic and varied assessments that make learning more meaningful and impactful.

COLLABORATIVE LEARNING

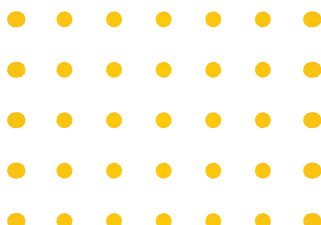
CO-CURRICULAR LEARNING

FLIPPED CLASSROOM LEARNING

PRE-SCHOOL WING

FACILITIES

AUDITORIUM

LANGUAGE LAB

IT LAB

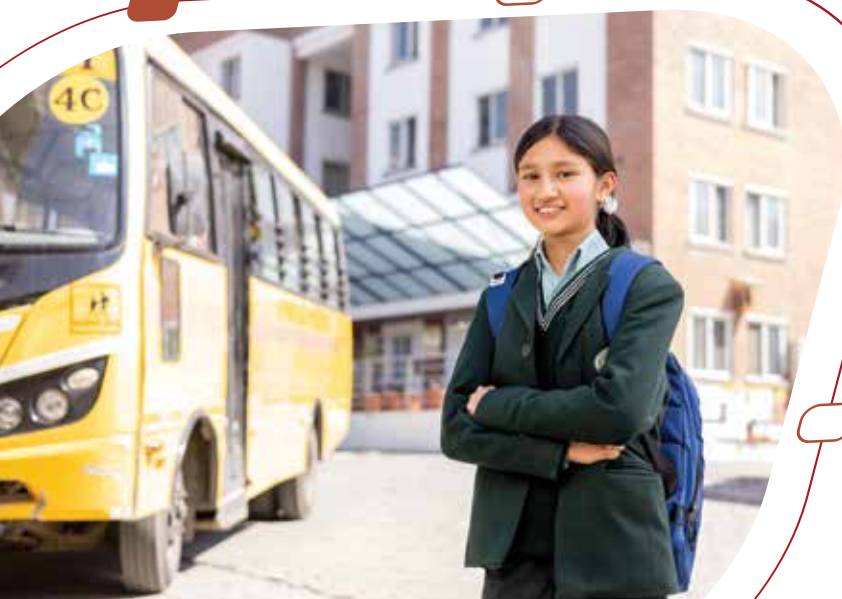
TRANSPORT

ADMISSIONS POLICY

We understand that admitting a child to a school is a crucial decision for parents and requires careful consideration. Our goal is to make the transition as smooth and stress-free as possible. Parents can reach out to our dedicated admissions staff to understand the admissions process. The information regarding the admissions support helpline is provided below:

STEP 1: Complete the registration form and attach photocopies of all relevant documents. Submit your application form to the Admissions Office within the stipulated time.

STEP 2: Registration is followed by an Entrance Examination and an interview.

STEP 3: The results of the admission tests are put up on the school notice board and website within 2 days from the date of the Entrance Examination.

STEP 4: Selected students must complete the admission formalities within 5 days from the publication of the results of the Entrance Examination.

STEP 5: Pay the admission fee, the annual charges, the school fee and other charges.

Application forms and information about fees are available at the school office in the 2nd week of Falgun.

Admission is considered based on the prescribed Registration Form, which is attached to this prospectus. The Registration Form must be

completed and registered by paying the registration fee. However, registration does not guarantee admission to the school. Registration is followed by an entrance examination and an interview.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Completed application form
- Progress report of the previous class
- Transfer certificate
- A copy of the birth certificate (only for Grade 1)

Admission is subject to the entrance exams (Grade 2- 8) and interview procedure (Grade 1) according to the availability of seats in the particular grade.

The Merit-Based Scholarship is awarded to the top three students of each class after every term. The top-ranking students of their entire class/grade receive a 75% scholarship on monthly tuition fees, the second-ranking student receives a 50% scholarship, and the third-ranking student receives a 25% scholarship. The scholarship is applicable for the duration of the upcoming academic session.

Uniform: The school uniform is mandatory for all students except those in Pre-School. Students must wear cultural attire every Wednesday and the school uniform on all other days. Detailed uniform guidelines are available at the school office.
